During its first operational phase (July 1999 – December 2002), EMWIS has build solid foundations at the organisational level as well as for raising awareness of Med Partner Countries about the interest of the necessary sharing of information and of developing National Water Information Systems (NWIS).

Today, EMWIS has 20 National Focal Points (NFP), 14 have published their web site on the Internet and 9 have collected information for the EMWIS thematic directory (Organizations, Contacts and Information Sources). These sites are offering a homogenous access to the available information on water in the concerned countries.

The European Commission contract covering the Phase II activities (2003-2006) has officially started the 1st December 2003, i.e. with 11 months delay considering the planning presented at the last Coordination Committee meeting in December 2002 in Tunis.

The aim of this co-ordination seminar is:

- to analyse the current progress of EMWIS and its National Focal Points
- to discuss the practical implementation of the EMWIS 2nd phase (2003-2006) in the different countries.
