

Med WS&D Report Phase I: Recommendations



- Water scarcity & Drought & Water Framework
 Directive
 - o WS&D can be addressed through WFD
 - **o** However, need to adapt the framework
 - Concepts: river basin; quantitative status
 - □ Instruments: water pricing; cost recovery principle
- Water scarcity & Drought & Risk management
 in the Mediterranean
 - Drought management plans
 - o Demand / supply side measures
- Water scarcity & Drought & need for further research in the Mediterranean



WATER SCARCITY - SCOPEATIVE











The **causes** of water scarcity largely depend on river basin characteristics and water uses.
